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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

You will be staying at the Double C Ranch. You can check out the amenities on our website, www.huntingwithjeff.com. We are located at 490 County Road 110, Crystal City, Texas 78839. For directions, visit our [website](#), click on "Double C info" at the top of the page and you will see a map along with driving instructions. The nearest commercial airport is the San Antonio International Airport, a two hour drive to the ranch. Most of our customers rent a car at the airport and drive down, however we do offer a shuttle bus service for \$850 (subject to change due to rising fuel cost) and must be reserved in advance. If you arrive in Texas early, we suggest staying overnight in downtown San Antonio, along the river walk, or there are hotels within ten minutes of our ranch in Crystal City (Winter Garden Inn, 830.374.0300 or Riata Inn, 830.374.5665) and in Carrizo Springs (Texan Inn, 830.876.9090).

When is the best time to come?

We hunt 360 days a year, and no one can predict Mother Nature or how the animals will act on a certain day. The ranch is open seven days a week. Our hunt schedule is as follows: Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Sunday, Monday, Tuesday or Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday. You have one year from the purchase date to complete your hunt. Be sure and make your reservations as soon as possible, as we are booking at least six months in advance. You can call the office, 830.374.2744, Monday through Thursday between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm CST and ask for Carley or Jeff, or you can e-mail carley@huntingwithjeff.com or jeff@huntingwithjeff.com. Please have an idea of what days you would like to reserve and we will go from there. All reservations must be confirmed via e-mail so there is a paper trail. This hunt is not transferable and not refundable.

Can I buy an extra hunting day?

Yes, if there is availability. One extra hunting day can be added for \$300 per hunter and this allows one additional hog.

Can I add a non-hunting guest?

Yes, if there is availability. The cost is \$250 for the three day/two night package or \$125 a night. This price includes lodging, meals/drinks and maid service. It does not include tips for the staff (kitchen, hostesses, housekeeping), which will be collected in the office at check out time.

Pets are not allowed.

How much is a Texas Non-Resident Hunting License for hogs and/or exotics?

The state of Texas charges \$48 for a five day non-resident adult license (17 years of age and older) and \$7 for a youth license (16 years of age and younger). Once you have dates reserved and confirmed through e-mail, please use the [registration](#) located at the bottom of our [website](#), fill out the required hunting license information and we can issue your Texas hunting license here at the ranch; upon arrival. If you want to purchase your hunting license in advance, you can do so by calling Texas Parks and Wildlife, 1.800.895.4248, Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 am and 6 pm, or online at [Texas license connection](#).

What time do I check in and check out?

Check in time is 1 pm (no earlier) and check out time is 11 am (no later). We need this time to prepare the rooms for arrival of new guests.

Items not included on the hunt:

Tips, hunting license, field dressing/gutting, skinning/quartering or processing with vacuum packing.

Can I field dress/gut and/or skin/quarter my own animals?

Since field dressing/gutting and skinning/quartering are not included in your hunt, you can do it yourself at no charge or we can do it for an additional fee. Field dressing/gutting is \$30 per hog and skinning/quartering is \$30 per hog. Please do not field dress any animals in the field.

How much is processing and vacuum packing?

For hogs weighing up to 100 lbs, the cost is \$50. For hogs weighing more than 100 lbs, the cost is .50¢ a lb. The price will be determined by the hanging weight before field dressing. The butcher will only be able to process hogs that are harvested on the first day and morning of the second day.

How much is it to ship my animal meat?

We do not recommend this as it is expensive and there is no insurance or protection. We ship via UPS next day air saver. A large box holds up to 50 lbs and is \$350, and a small box holds up to 25 lbs and is \$175. These prices include the styrofoam shipping box, gel packs, shipping charges and handling. The price quoted is for the lower 48 states and is subject to change due to price increase or decrease with UPS. If you are flying and do not want to ship meat, you can purchase our boxes, large \$40 each or small \$25 each, along with gel packs, \$5 each, and check the box and/or boxes with your luggage. Your airlines may charge an extra baggage fee. Or, you can donate your meat to a local church for an additional fee. This fee is for the field dressing/gutting and skinning/quartering charges to prepare your meat for donation.

How much should I expect to tip?

All tips are just that, a tip, and should only be left if you are completely satisfied with the service our staff performed for you. The suggested tip for your guide varies with the specie harvested, the number of animals harvested and how hard your guide worked to put you on the animals. We like for each hunter to tip their guide in person. The tips for the staff (kitchen, hostesses and housekeeping) will be collected in the office at check out time. If you have any suggestions, compliments or complaints, please do so at check out time, as we are always seeking suggestions for improvements to our operation!

What should I bring?

We have a lighted skeet range and provide clay targets, so you can bring your shot gun. We have a 22 range if you want to bring your 22. We have a lake stocked with black bass (catch/release program) and provide fishing gear, but you are welcome to bring your own. We also have a heated swimming pool (heated upon request) and hot tub if you want to bring your swimsuit. Do not forget ammo, eye protection, ear protection, insect repellent, sunscreen and snacks to take with you to the blind.

What to expect on my hunt?

We hunt from blinds (ground and elevated) overlooking feeders with LED night lights. Your guide will drop you off at your blind and pick you back up. The average shooting distance is 75 to 100 yards. The hogs we hunt range anywhere from 30 to 300 pounds, however the average hog harvested weighs between 100 to 125 pounds. We suggest using a 25-06 rifle or larger with some sort of illuminated cross hair because most of the hogs are harvested in low light conditions. We do allow bow hunting, muzzle loaders and hand guns, but the success rate is drastically reduced. All hunters will be required to shoot their rifles at our rifle range before the hunt can begin. We do offer a \$50 credit for any varmint harvested (coyote, badger, bobcat or fox) and this credit will reflect on your invoice at check out time.

What should I wear?

We recommend camouflage. You do not need snake leggings because there is very little walking or stalking. Please check our weather link which is located on the home page of our [website](#) to help you with what type of clothing to bring.

Registration:

Once dates are reserved and confirmed through e-mail, please use the [registration](#) located at the bottom of our [website](#). Make sure everyone in your group registers. The group name should be the name of the person who purchased the hunt and/or made the reservations. It is also important to enter the correct date of arrival.
